The Ward-Leven House, built circa 1840 by the Ward family, then-owner of the Conference House and surrounds, is the second oldest house in the park today.

The house has been vacant since it was acquired by the Parks Dept. in the 1990s.

The Tottenville Historical Society, a park-partner organization, hopes to rehabilitate and occupy the house with plans for use as a resource center, gallery and public meeting space.
